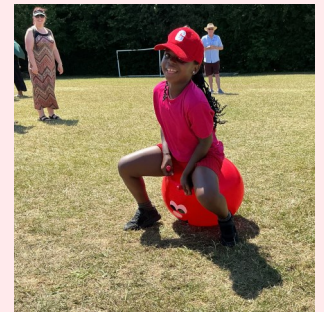
There was a lot of information but we realised that we already knew so much about how to stay safe and how to cope with anything that made us feel uncomfortable.

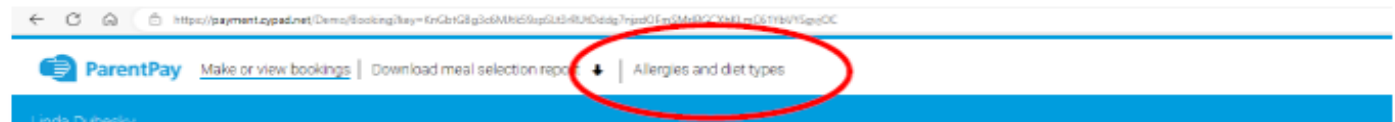
Message from Chartwells

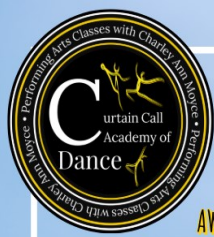

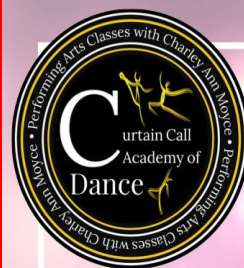

THE HIGHDOWN BIG DIG 2025

Highdown Hill, West Sussex
19 July – 1 August 2025

Join us for a unique opportunity to witness archaeology in action at Highdown Hill, one of West Sussex's most historically rich landscapes. The **Highdown Big Dig 2025** will see **Worthing Museum** join forces with the **National Trust Archaeology** and **Worthing Archaeological Society** for this community big dig.

This rare chance allows you to watch archaeologists at work, find out what we've uncovered and learn more about the history of the area with free tours and workshops suitable for children and adults.

What are we hoping to discover? Well, Highdown Hill is a place full of incredible history dating back to the Late Bronze Age and Iron Age. We know there was once a Roman Bath House and an early Saxon Cemetery. We might find jewellery, weaponry, glassware and maybe even skeletal remains.

Big Dig Open Day

Join us on **Saturday 26 July** for The Big Dig Open Day where we will have the Weorod living history group demonstrate Anglo-Saxon life, flint knapping-demonstrations, bug hunts hosted by The National Trust Ranger team, workshops for kids and adults and the chance to see artefacts uncovered so far.

All artefacts uncovered at The Big Dig will be showcased in a major exhibition at Worthing Museum next year.
